- Vehicles must be removed from the Showgrounds and parked in the appropriate Exhibitor Carpark BEFORE 8.30am.
- Please ensure you and anyone handling your Goats have signed a Waiver and received a wristband.
- All exhibitors must pay the gate entry fee unless Members. Special Livestock Exhibitor fee is \$10.00 per exhibitor and handlers is available at the livestock gate entrance or online

EXHIBITORS MUST SUPPLY A SIGNED GOAT HEALTH DECLATARION AND A TSS OR NVD FOR LIVESTOCK MOVEMENT REQUIREMENTS.

The Biosecurity (NLIS) Regulation 2017 permits the movement of dairy goats and goats born without ears (earless goats) between properties, including events such as shows where dairy goats are exhibited, without a visual NLIS ear tag.

PLEASE NOTE: Judging will cease at 12.30 pm in preparation for the Grand Parade

CONDITIONS:

- 1 Goats must be registered with the Goat Breeders' Society of Australia, either in the Numbered or Appendix Sections of the Herd Book. Identification must be included on entry form.
- 2 The age of goats will be calculated from date of birth to judging day.
- 3 All goats must be free of infections and contagious disease and vermin.
- 4 All goats must take part in the Grand Parade as requested by the Steward.
- 5 All exhibitors are requested to wear a dust coat in the judging ring and for the Grand

Parade.

- 6 HDAA Stewards' decision on any matter will be final.
- 7 HDAA Stewards' reserve the right to reject any animal.
- 8 All goats must remain on the Showground until 4.30pm on the day of judging.
- 9 All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
- Doe kid classes will be split if there are sufficient entries. 10
- AOB (Any other Breed includes Nigerian Dwarf, Lamancha, Alpine, Sable) if two or more breeds are 11 exhibiting, the class will be split according to their breed standard.

ANIMAL WELFARE POLICY
