NOVICE CLASS (less than 18months experience and all own work)

Class 16200 Patchwork article, Hand or domestic machine pieced, **not quilted** e.g. Place mats, cushion cover, quilt panel, bag or purse. **Maximum size 150cm x 150cm.**

Class 16201 Patchwork article, Hand or domestic machine pieced and **quilted** e.g. Place mats, cushion cover, quilt panel, bag or purse. **Maximum size 150cm x 150cm.**

BEST EXHIBIT IN NOVICE PATCHWORK- Ribbon & Voucher donated by Fortunes & Fairies, Richmond.

OPEN CLASS

Class 16202 Table Runner, pieced and quilted

Class 16203 Wall Hanging, **Maximum size 120cm x 120cm.** Must have rod pocket, ready for hanging. Hand or machine pieced, and hand or domestic machine Quilted.

Class 16204 Small Quilt or Knee Rug, **Maximum size 150cm x150cm.** Hand or machine pieced, and hand or domestic machine Quilted.

Class 16205 Scrappy Quilt, made from left over or recycled materials. **Maximum size 180cm x 220cm.** Hand or Domestic Machine pieced and quilted.

Class 16206 Small Quilt made by one person and commercially quilted by another person. **Maximum size 150cm x 150cm.**

Class 16207 Patchwork Quilt made by one person and commercially quilted by another person. **Maximum size 180cm x 220cm.**

Class 16208 Embellished Quilt, hand or domestic machine pieced and quilted with added embellishments such as beadwork, buttons and/or applique. **Maximum size 180cm x 220cm.**

Class 16209 Household Patchwork or article e.g., Place mats, cushion Cover, Bag, or purse
