- **ENTRY FEE:** \$3.00 Payment can be made by cheque (to Hawkesbury District Agricultural Association), Credit Card, or cash ONLY. CASH not accepted through mail.

- **Late entries will be accepted on the day.**
- **ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS:** Entry Forms and Waivers can be downloaded from www.hawkesburyshowground.com.au. Each exhibitor and any other person that handles the animal must sign a waiver on the day of entry and get a wristband.
- **DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS:** All Goats must be delivered to the Showground by 8:30am on the day of Judging (25th April) Please enter the Showground via **Gate 3**, 40 Racecourse Road, Clarendon.
- Vehicles must be removed from the Showgrounds and parked in the appropriate Exhibitor Carpark BEFORE 8.30am.
- Please ensure you and anyone handling your Goats have signed a Waiver and received a wristband.
- **All exhibitors must pay the gate entry fee unless Members. Special Livestock Exhibitor fee is \$10.00 per exhibitor and handlers is available at the livestock gate entrance or online**

- **JUDGING:** Saturday 25th April 2026 commencing at 10.00am
- **PRIZES:** 1st \$10.00, 2nd \$5.00, 3rd ribbon as listed. Champions as listed *All fees & prizes include GST.* Prize vouchers should be collected from the Steward and presented for payment either during the Show at the cash office or after the show at the Secretary's office by **FRIDAY 29th May 2026**

EXHIBITORS MUST SUPPLY A SIGNED GOAT HEALTH DECLARATION AND A TSS OR NVD FOR LIVESTOCK MOVEMENT REQUIREMENTS.

The Biosecurity (NLIS) Regulation 2017 permits the movement of dairy goats and goats born without ears (earless goats) between properties, including events such as shows where dairy goats are exhibited, without a visual NLIS ear tag.

PLEASE NOTE: Judging will cease at 12.30 pm in preparation for the Grand Parade

CONDITIONS:

- 1 Goats must be registered with the Goat Breeders' Society of Australia, either in the Numbered or Appendix Sections of the Herd Book. Identification must be included on entry form.
- 2 The age of goats will be calculated from date of birth to judging day.
- 3 All goats must be free of infections and contagious disease and vermin.
- 4 All goats must take part in the Grand Parade as requested by the Steward.
- 5 All exhibitors are requested to wear a neat attire and enclosed shoes.

- 6 HDAA Stewards' decision on any matter will be final.
- 7 HDAA Stewards' reserve the right to reject any animal.
- 8 All goats must remain on the Showground until 4.30pm on the day of judging.
- 9 All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
- 10 Doe kid classes will be split if there are sufficient entries.

ANIMAL WELFARE POLICY

Hawkesbury District Agricultural Association (HDAA) provides for the welfare and how we treat animals on the showground. The expectations and requirements are for the care of animals and if exhibitors breach these conditions HDAA may take action if required through ejecting the involved exhibitor and/or reporting the incident to the RSPCA for legal action.

An Exhibitor or Attendant of an Animal Exhibit must use all reasonable steps to ensure that the exhibit is housed and cared for in accordance with the Animal Welfare Policy.

Animal Welfare is a human responsibility that encompasses all aspects of animal well being.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Proper housing
- Management
- Nutrition
- Responsible care
- Humane handling, and
- Veterinary treatment
