Please read conditions of entry

- **ENTRY FEE:** \$10.00 per animal which covers entry into all classes. This also includes one gate entry ticket for the exhibitor.
Payment can be made by cheque (to Hawkesbury District Agricultural Association), Credit Card, or cash ONLY. CASH not accepted through mail.
- **ENTRIES CLOSE:** by POST - Hawkesbury Show Office PO Box 382 Richmond 2753 or at Showground - Gate 2, 40 Racecourse Road, Clarendon on FRIDAY 17th April 2026 BY 4.00pm

- **Late entries will be accepted on the day.**
- **ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS:** Entry Forms and Waivers can be downloaded from www.hawkesburyshowground.com.au. Each exhibitor and any other person that handles the animal must sign a waiver on the day of entry and get a wristband.
- **DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS:** All Goats and Sheep must be delivered to the Showground by 8:30am on the day of Judging (26th April 2026). Please enter the Showground via **Gate 4**, 40 Racecourse Road, Clarendon.
- Vehicles must be removed from the Showgrounds and parked in the appropriate Exhibitor Carpark BEFORE 8.30am.
- **All exhibitors must pay the gate entry fee unless Members. Special Livestock Exhibitor fee is \$10.00 per exhibitor and handlers is available at the livestock gate entrance or online – Use Class 5000 - LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR GATE ENTRY TICKET**
- **JUDGING:** Sunday 26th April 2026 commencing at 10.00am
- **PRIZES:** 1st, 2nd, 3rd ribbon. Highest Point score 1st-\$50.00, 2nd-\$25.00 in each section. *All fees & prizes include GST.* Prize vouchers should be collected from the Steward and presented for payment either during the Show at the cash office or after the show at the Secretary's office by **FRIDAY 29th May 2026**

POINT SCORE: 1st - 3 points, 2nd – 2 points, 3rd – 1 point.

CONDITIONS:

- 1 All exhibits must have an ear tag.
- 2 All exhibits must be free of infections and contagious disease and vermin.
- 3 HDAA Stewards' decision on any matter will be final.
- 4 HDAA Stewards reserves the right to reject any animal.
- 5 All exhibits must remain on the Showground until 4.30pm on the day of judging.
- 6 All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
- 7 All animals must be supervised by a handler at all times whilst in the pavilion.
- 8 All legally required paperwork must accompany all livestock.

ANIMAL WELFARE POLICY

Hawkesbury District Agricultural Association (HDAA) provides for the welfare and how we treat animals on the showground. The expectations and requirements are for the care of animals and if exhibitors breach these conditions HDAA may take action if required through ejecting the involved exhibitor and/or reporting the incident to the RSPCA for legal action.

An Exhibitor or Attendant of an Animal Exhibit must use all reasonable steps to ensure that the exhibit is housed and cared for in accordance with the Animal Welfare Policy.

Section 1 Pet Goats.

Each exhibit is eligible to enter every class.

Class 1001 – Pet Goats – if sufficient entries are received, we will split the class into “big” and “little” sizes.

- 3 Junior handler – Exhibitor 13 years and under 18 years
- 4 Senior handler – Exhibitor 18 years and over
- 5 Most unusual colored goat
- 6 Most unusual pattern goat
- 7 Tallest Goat
- 8 Smallest Goat
- 9 Goat with the longest beard
- 10 Goat with the biggest ears
- 11 Goat with the biggest horns
- 12 Goat who looks most like its handler
- 13 Hairiest goat
- 14 Goat with the waggiest tail
- 15 Goat with the best trick – show us your skills

There will be a break in judging to allow exhibitors to prepare for the Fancy Dress classes

- 16 Fancy dress – goat only
- 17 Fancy Dress – goat and handler

Highest Point Scoring Goat – 1st – Sash and \$50.00, 2nd Sash and \$25, 3rd - Sash

Section 2 Pet Sheep.

Each exhibit is eligible to enter every class.

Class 1002 – Pet Sheep – if sufficient entries are received, we will split the class into “big” and “little” sizes.
