BREED SHOW DETAILS for HAWKESBURY SHOW

DAY OF JUDGING: FRIDAY 9TH MAY 2025

SHOW MANAGER: Belle Janes

SHOW CHIEF STEWARD: Jenna Sinclair



Entry Fees: Minimum entry of \$25 will apply to each exhibitor to cover entry and car passes to the show (1-5 entries/classes)

MAIN SHOW: \$5 PER RABBIT PER CLASS.
ENTRIES WILL BE CAPPED AT \$60 EACH EXHIBITOR (12 CLASSES OR MORE)

<u>VETTING IN:</u> Vetting in will start at 6.30am and finish at 8am, All exhibits must be penned by no later than 8.30am ready for judging at 9am. Please line up as you arrive, late arrivals after 8.30am may not be excepted. Exhibits must be in good health, any rabbits that look sick or display ill health may be vetted out.

BUMP IN: Delivery of exhibits are to be between 6.30am – 8.30am only.

Due to venue requirements all exhibitors much have a car pass on display and valid ticket per person to enter the venue, cars are to be parked at the designated area near the hall inside the show grounds and cannot be removed until Bump Out time, if you need to leave during the day, you will need to park in the pedestrians carpark at the back or front of the showground gates and walk back in the grounds with your ticket.

<u>PARKING:</u> As per above Bump in details, please have your car pass always displayed with your contact details clearly visible on your dash.

<u>ENTRY PASSES/TICKETS:</u> 1 Show entry pass will be supplied to each exhibitor for the day of judging. There may be some extra spare tickets available for children and junior exhibitors, this will be confirmed closer to close of entries.

<u>BUMP OUT:</u> No exhibits shall leave the hall until 5pm, no exceptions due to safety of other pedestrians around the showgrounds and because all exhibits still need to be on display until 5pm.

THE PAVILLION/HALL: The hall is open to the public from 9am – 5pm. Judging will start promptly at 9am. No public are permitted to enter the judging and exhibits area for the safety and well-being of all exhibits. Only official stewards are allowed into the judging area to help with stewarding the exhibits.

ENTRIES CLOSE: MONDAY 7TH APRIL 2025 - NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

<u>PAYMENT FOR ENTRIES:</u> Entry fees must be paid in full when submitting your entry form.

Monies are to be paid into the following account National Australia Bank (NAB) - Rabbit Breeders

Association of NSW inc - BSB 082-753 A/C 184509249 receipt for payment and reference must accompany your entry form. **Payment on the day of the show will not be accepted.**

<u>SCRATCHINGS:</u> No refunds will be given for rabbits scratched after entries closing date. All scratching or withdrawals will need to be emailed directly to the show manager. On the day scratching's need to be submitted to the show manager no later than 8am or a \$40 fine will apply.

SHOW PREPARATION DETAILS

<u>GROOMING:</u> Power will be available at a designated area for those that need to groom exhibits before judging commences, bring your own equipment and please clean up your own mess.

<u>VACCINATION</u>: although it's not a requirement, it is advised that your exhibits have been recently vaccinated with Filavac due to the current release of RHDV2, consideration by the judge will be given for a small patch of missing fur, redness, small lump at the injection site due to the vaccination, please note on your entries if recent vaccinations have been given. Under no circumstances can you identify this to the judge on the day.

<u>PENNING</u>: All exhibits will need to be in a clean and tidy carry show cage with an easily accessible door for stewards to be able to take the exhibit out for judging. Cage curtains are advised and a fly net to also put over your carriers, all exhibits must have a wire base or grass mat for the exhibit to sit on. No names or any other identifying labels should be on the show cage.

Each exhibit will have their own penning number allocated to them on judging day, please always keep your copy with you.

<u>WATER AND FOOD:</u> Water and food must be available to exhibits at all times, Pellet food, wheatbix or hay cubes are recommended for long travelling exhibits. Attachable water bottles are recommended or small water bowls.

JUDGING AND SHOW DAY

WHAT HAPPENS ON SHOW DAY

After all show preparations have been completed, judging will commence.

Those that have been selected for exhibit stewarding, photographers, runners, bookkeeper and card writers will remain in the arena, other exhibitors will need to leave the arena and sit in the spectator's area or are free to leave the hall and enjoy other parts of the Hawkesbury Show.

HOW THE SHOW WILL RUN:

Our 4 breed sections (Fancy, Lop, Fur and Rex) and our other classes (unrung and pet classes) will be assessed as normal with stewards taking the exhibits to the judges table for assessment.

When it's time for the final line-ups to be assessed, the exhibit stewards will take all the final line up exhibits to the main (final line up table) judging area. Stewards will be present at the table when the judge is assessing the final line-ups, along with the bookkeeper and photographer.

Since the judging will be on public display, Stewards must remain silent at the judges table at all times (unless there is a general safety concern) the spectators must be able to hear the judge speaking whilst making their assessments and whilst they're communicating to the book steward.







DISPLAY TABLE AND GUEST SPEAKERS

On the opposite side of the hall whilst judging commences, there will be a table with important rabbit information, show and club details. There will also be a number of experienced guest speakers educating and showing the members of the public specific breeds known and shown here in Australia.





CLASS, AGE CLASSIFICATIONS & COLOUR GUIDE

<u>RUNG CLASSES</u>: The main breed show is made up of exhibits that have a registered ring or a tattoo identification number on their leg or inside their ear, exhibits that don't have an identification number will be classed as either "Unrung" or "pet"

Unrung: for exhibits that fit the (British Rabbit Council standards) category but don't have an identification ring or number.

Pet: for exhibits that don't fit into any standard category and don't have an identification ring or tattoo. Pet exhibits will be assessed differently to the standard.

AGE CLASSIFICATIONS: A birth date is required for all exhibits to confirm that the exhibit is placed in the correct age class.

KITTEN: Must be over 10 weeks of age, but under 14 weeks.

JUNIOR: 14 weeks of age and under 5 months*

ADULT: Over 5 months of age, except for the Flemish giant chinchilla giganta breeds that shall be 6 months and over. (Flemish giant and chinchilla giganta shall be under 6 months for the junior age class).

<u>COLOUR GUIDE:</u> Most classes are broken down into specific colour classes for various breeds, so its important to have your exhibit in the correct class for their colour and breed.

Red Eyed White (REW) = as pure white coat as possible and eyes to be ruby red in colour.

Self Class - Blue Eyed White (BEW) = as pure white coat as possible and eyes to be bright blue in colour. **Ivory** = specifically to the satin breed, eye colour to be red or blue.

Self = black, blue, brown/chocolate, lilac, blue eyed white. (colour must be in full with no other colour in coat)

Shaded = Siamese sable, smoke pearl, seal point, blue point, iron grey, chocolate tort, sooty fawn, beige. **Tan Pattern =** fox, otter and tan (in black, blue, lilac or chocolate) marten sable, smoke pearl,

marten.

Agouti pattern: = agouti/castor/brown grey, opal, lynx, chinchilla, cinnamon, squirrel.

Any other Colour: Any other colour conforming to the breeds individual breed standard, for example Himalayan, steel, fawn, orange/ buttery/broken unless a separate class is offered for the breed.

COLOUR DEFINITIONS: For REX and MINI REX only.

Ermine = As pure white as possible with ruby red eye colour.

Self = black, blue, lilac, chocolate.

Shaded = Siamese sable, Siamese smoke pearl, seal, tortoiseshell.

Tan Pattern = smoke peal marten, marten sable, marten seal, orange, fawn, fox, otter and tan (in black, blue, chocolate and lilac)

ORANGE - Orange class only

Agouti pattern = castor, chinrex, cinnamon, lynx and opal.

STD REX AOC - Broken, Himalayan, Dalmations, harlequin, all other accepted colours

MINI REX = BROKEN

MINI REX AOC - Himalayan, Dalmations, harlequin, all other accepted colours
